



JOHN & JESS TAKE THE CASH

Evergreen 72 year old **John Justice** has taken the bulk of the spoils at the Bendigo Athletic Club's Gala Presentation Night held at the Quality Inn Colonial in Golden Square. Justice won the prestigious RetireInvest Dick Kitt Memorial 6500 metre Final, a race set aside for the top twenty athletes of the season.

Justice ran a time of 28.29 minutes to win the final from Grant Findlay 27.03 & Rick Ermel 23.24 minutes.

A winning margin of 26 seconds in the sealed handicap event gained Justice sufficient points to take the overall aggregate with 147 points, ahead of Grant Findlay 131 & Paul Bennett on 120.

Justice forged his way into the Dick Kitt Memorial Final following a resounding win in Race Eight of the BAC season, the Purtills Nursery 8000 metres Handicap held at the Bendigo Livestock Exchange in Huntly. One of the top veteran's in the world for his age, Justice ran a great time of 35.13 minutes, upstaging many of his younger competitors.

Over many years Justice has been at the top of his game for his age, winning at Master's championships & producing some world leading performances.
