



Runners let Jeremy bolt on Crusoe 8km

First year runner Jeremy Bolton has raced to a 4 second win in the latest Bendigo Athletic Club race, the Ian Symon's Dairies 8000 metres held at No.7 Park at Crusoe Reservoir in Kangaroo Flat.



In a field of 40 runners, Bolton ran a time of 32.44 minutes, to run down Rod Skidmore 36.08 minutes and regular placegetter Mark Stevens in third place. Fastest time of the day honours went to Brendan O'Brien in 29.00 minutes, ahead of Greg Hilson 29.16 & Rick Ermel 29.46, with the Fastest Female time of 33.03 minutes being clocked by Kिरrily Burnett.

The Gillies Pie Shop Ladies award points went to Jessica O'Hara, from Lyn Crome & Kिरrily Burnett. O'Hara also collected the honour of being first under 23 to finish, ahead of Burnett, with Lachlan Shelton in third place.

The winner of the Mark & Liz Findlay Under 23 award at the end of the season will receive \$200.00 The RetireInvest Veteran points were collected by Rod Skidmore, from Mark Stevens and John Justice

Young gun Xavier Hutchison took out the Children's 1km race, running a time of 5.07 minutes to beat Josh Doherty & Matthew Noden.

Dane Heiden ran fastest time of 3.40 minutes, just 3 seconds quicker than Fastest Female, Demi Goodall-Hoffman 3.43 minutes.

There is no race next weekend, being the Queen's Birthday Long Weekend.

The next race will be when Melbourne & Bendigo runners again get together on Sunday 20th June for Country Victoria's Richest Professional Road Race, the RetireInvest Eaglehawk to Bendigo, with \$1,000 going to the race winner.
