



John gets Justice at Livestock Exchange

Evergreen 72 year old John Justice has raced to a great victory in the latest Bendigo Athletic Club Cross Country race, the Purtills Nursery 8000 metres Handicap held at the Bendigo Livestock Exchange in Huntly.

One of the top veteran's in the world for his age, Justice ran a great time of 35.13 minutes, upstaging many of his younger competitors.

It was a day for the veteran athletes, filling all top ten placings, with Grant Findlay finishing in second place & Club President Mark Stevens third.

Josh Nolan ran the fastest time of the day, 29.27 minutes. Rick Ermel was next best with 29.47 & Anthony Hutchison third fastest in 30.06.

First & Fastest Female on the day was Kerrieanne Hocking, stopping the clock in 35.33 minutes and sixth place overall. Jacob Nolan was the first under 23 athlete on handicap, finishing aband of his older brother Losh, whilet last weak's

finishing ahead of his older brother Josh, whilst last week's overall race winner Lachlan Shelton picked up the third placed points.

Having her first run with the club, Sancia Carlile took out the Children's Race over 1000 metres, runnig second fastest time of 4.24 minutes.

Frontmarker Jed Bibby finished in 2nd place, ahead of fastest time runner Demi Goodall-Hoffman claiming third place in 3.35 minutes.

Bendigo Athletic Club members will head to Murchison this Sunday for the running of the 37th Annual 'Murchison 10000'. The handicapped event starts at 12 noon with \$250.00 going to the winner.

BAC members will be joined by Victorian Cross Country League (VCCL) runners.

On paper the two main chances from Bendigo appear to be Anthony Hutchison & Kevin Shanahan, however, other in form


local athletes such as Grant Findlay, Kerrieanne Hocking & David Ottrey all should be considered a chance for a top ten finish.
