

Barkmeyer Electrics 5km finds some Spark in Stacey's step!

Shepparton's Stacey Clarkson has clinched the final race of the Bendigo Athletic Club's Cross Country season, the Çarl Barkmeyer Electrics 5000 metres handicap held in Bendigo on Sunday.

After minor placings in her last three runs, Clarkson ran to the front with less than 200 metres to go, leaving Melinda Gilligan in second place and Richard Schultz, third.

Clarkson's run earned her the fastest female time of 20.54 minutes, ahead of Lyn Crome & Melinda Gilligan.

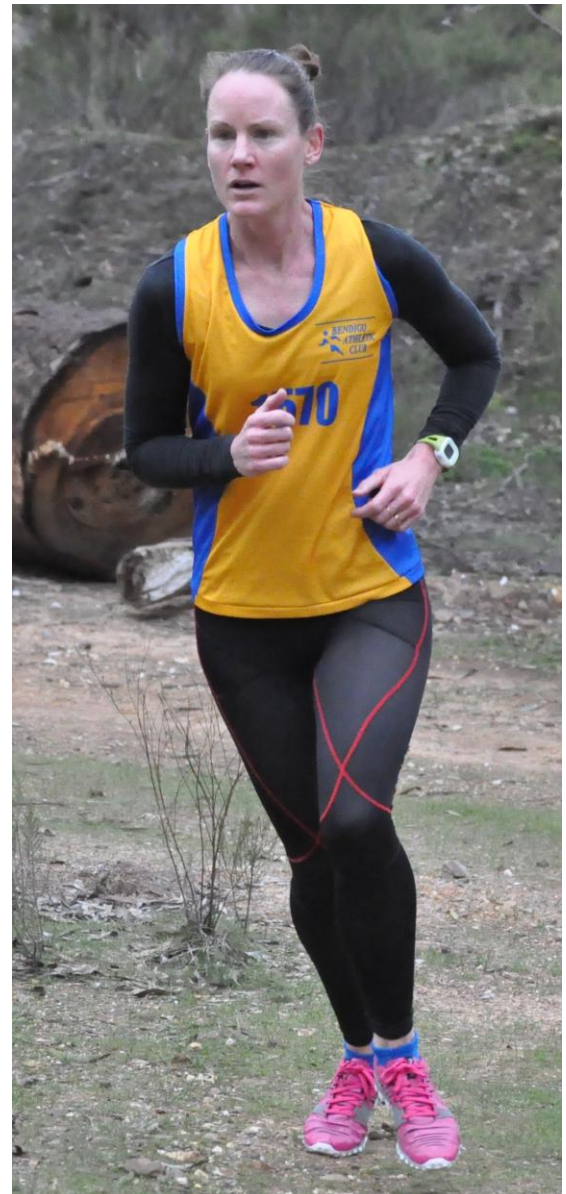
The Bridge Hotel Open Aggregate points also went to Stacey Clarkson, ahead of Melinda Gilligan & Jeremy Boulton.

It goes without saying, but Clarkson also won the points in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Ladies Award from Melinda Gilligan & Rhonda Schultz in third place.

Club Champion Josh Sait rebounded this week to take the fastest time honors away from Jacob Nolan.

Sait ran 17.29 minutes, whilst Nolan had to settle for 2nd fastest this week, recording 17.47 minutes, with Brendan O'Brien next best with 19.33 minutes.

This week's Flack Advisory Veterans Award placing went to Richard Schultz, John Bailey & Rhonda Schultz.



For the first time this season, Jacob Nolan was the only runner in the Liz & Mark Findlay under 23 Award, claiming maximum points.

Ada Ford ran a great race to win the Children's 1000 metre handicap, whilst Connor Findlay & Jaymin Boulton stormed home to finish in second & third positions respectively.

Bree Heiden recorded the fastest time of 4.10 minutes.
